We are looking for artists to apply to have their work shown at this year's Art Matters Festival. You may submit past projects, current projects, or works in progress. Projects must be well thought out and well articulated, take your time to write your proposal, be clear, read it over; it is your application that will be speaking for you in the jurying process. We highly suggest consulting our website for a list of our selected curators/artistic directors' themes. This year we ask that all artists indicate which theme(s) you think your project would be best suited for. Although your project may be selected for any show, this will increase the chances of your project being presented in the show that's right for you. The jury will take into consideration the overall quality of the proposal package.

The Art Matters Festival aims to provide emerging artists with experience, a venue, publicity, transportation, technical equipment and partial funding. One of the goals of the festival is to provide students an opportunity to exhibit in a professional context.

Only registered undergraduate Concordia students are eligible to participate as artists. You may apply as an individual or as a group.

4. A cd containing relevant video clips MPEG/ images(6max) JPEG PLEASE!
